Auto Gas Report — The club now has a new above-ground fuel tank with electric pump, new flow meter, new hose and spigot, delivered at no charge by the auto fuel supplier. Price for autogas is \$2.70 per gallon. Fuel is 91 octane, contains no alcohol and conforms with most auto gas STCs. Bill Roe wants to buy the old fuel tank. Chad Williams set a price of \$150 complete except that the club will keep the lock.

Rent Increase — During the December 2015 meeting the club voted to enact a monthly rent increase of \$10 per hangar, effective upon signing a new lease.

New EAA STC for Dynon Instrument — The EAA has recently announced a new STC for some small type certificated aircraft for the Dynon solid-state artificial horizon instrument. At the meeting date the club does not have a details on the cost of or the STC, but this is essentially the same instrument that Chuck Leucht has in his RV-9A.

Spring Clean-Up Planning — The annual airport clean-up day is scheduled for Saturday, April 23. Among planned projects:

- Fill taxiway potholes with cold patch
- Repaint runway center lines
- Repaint yellow airport frequency numbers
- Replace front fence; property owner will provide materials and Tom Rich will provide a posthole digger
- Dig a trench to bury the cable for autogas pump, or put up a tension reel
- Clean maintenance hangar

Treasurer's Report — Check account balance is \$3,219.36, general savings balance is \$12,932.61, and fuel savings balance is \$3,857.69. Dick Gurley notified the club that the general savings balance is temporarily high because we have not been paying our property rent due to the status of the lease. Much of that balance will go away when we catch up on our lease payments. All other expenses to date are paid. At the next meeting Dick will have an accounting of who owes money on rent and/or fuel.

Maintenance Hangar — Dick Gurley reports that to date the club has received no money this year for the use of the maintenance hangar. The maintenance hangar is available exclusively to club members; the rental price is \$10 per day.

Red Bull Air Racing — The Red Bull Air Race will be held at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway in October this year. We will have more details on the race at a future meeting.

Other Events — Westfield Airport is hosting a pancake breakfast this Saturday. From 11:30 to 4:00 p.m. Purdue University is hosting an Aviation Day at Purdue Airport. Pilots planning on flying in are asked to pre-register via the website.

Trash Pickup — The club is now saving some money with the trash dumpster locked; we are getting one pickup per month. Earl Brosman has been cleaning up around the property and says we need an additional pickup this month. Chad Williams will post a number to call for an additional pickup.

Fraud Report — Chad Williams reported that we received a call from Indianapolis police, who stated that someone wanted \$7,000 in cash for a package that was claimed to be flown to the airport. The claim was determined to be a hoax, but members are asked to check out any suspicious activity at or around the airport.

Maintenance Hangar — Dick Gurley reports that to date the club has received no money this year for the use of the maintenance hangar. The maintenance hangar is available exclusively to club members; the rental price is \$10 per day.

Upcoming Club Elections — Chad Williams reminded the club to look ahead to the annual club elections coming up in July. Due to family commitments Chad will not be running for re-election so the club needs to look inward for a new presidential candidate.

Adjournment — Steve McClure motioned to adjourn the meeting; Dick Gurley seconded. The meeting was adjourned.
